Students will gain an understanding of basic compositional elements such as texture, line and value, while experimenting with different painting and drawing materials in combination. Pictures of established artists' works will be shown to provide inspiration for students' individual designs. Students will be expected to talk about their project ideas before and after completion to establish dialogue about personal expectations. \$30 materials fee which includes all painting/drawing materials, paper and canvas.

Beginning Watercolor

Class Comment: This is an introductory class in basic watercolor techniques and processes. Some drawing experience advisable, but not required. If you have taken this class before, you may take it again as the projects will vary slightly. Students will work from direct observation as well as from photographs and magazines. Dry brush, wash, and wet-into-wet methods will be explored as well as the effects of using liquid mask, salt and other materials to control and alter the watercolor. This is an extremely exploratory class with a focus on experimentation. Bring a pad no smaller than 12x 18 with tear-out sheets of water-color paper (rough or smooth) or other appropriate paper for water media the first day of class, along with hard lead pencil (H). We will work on a variety of paper surfaces. A supply list will be available during the first class.

Intermediate Watercolor

Class Comment: Students will use watercolor techniques and processes learned in the beginning class and will work to improve their skills. Some drawing experience is required, as well as experience with water media. Students will work from direct observation as well as from photographs and magazines. The focus of this class will be on creating fully-developed watercolor paintings. Come to class prepared with a pad or block of watercolor paper 18x24, a selection of watercolor paints in tubes or cakes, brushes of various sizes, a paint tray, and water bucket. Suggestions for additional materials will be discussed during class.

Minimum enrollment 6 / Maximum 15.
